


Video: Do I need a vaccine if I've already had COVID-19?

Recent studies on people infected early in the epidemic suggest antibodies may last up to 8 months or more.

However, because the strength of antibody protection can wane with time—sometimes quickly in individuals who are older or immuno-compromised—it is important to still get a <u>vaccine</u> even if you have had COVID-19.
